No extensions or exceptions will be granted.**

Activities or programs that have not been previously funded with CDBG should be reviewed with OCD staff prior to submitting an application to ensure HUD eligibility.

OCD staff is available to meet with all potential applicants until January 10, 2017 provide technical assistance with proposal development.

Please note that the FFY2017 Applications have been revised from previous versions. Application forms from previous years will not be accepted.

Direct assistance to individuals or families is not provided.

FFY2017 funding will be for activities from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018. The City of Holyoke CDBG Allocation has not yet been released by HUD.
