NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SIXTH AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 86 OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HOLYOKE, MASSACHUSETTS 1997

AN ORDINANCE

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Holyoke as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 86-106 entitled "Permit parking" of Division I entitled "Generally" of Article IV entitled "Stopping, Standing, Parking" of Chapter 86 entitled "Traffic and Vehicles" of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Holyoke, Massachusetts, 1997, as amended, is hereby further amended by the following:

DELETING:

- (f) Spaces designated as "Permit Parking Only" on Barrett Avenue, Elting Circle, Leary Drive, Little Avenue and Yoerg Circle shall require a permit issued by the Holyoke housing authority to residents of housing authority property. Any person who violates this section, in addition to the fine provided for pursuant to subsection (b) may also have their vehicle towed by the city at the direction of the housing authority in accordance with the procedures set forth in division 2 of article IV herein.


ADDING in its place:

- (f) Spaces designated as "Permit Parking Only" on Barrett Avenue, Elting Circle, Leary Drive, Little Avenue, Yoerg Circle, Oliver Street and lower Hampden Street, shall require a permit issued by the Holyoke housing authority to residents of housing authority property. Any person who violates this section, in addition to the fine provided for pursuant to subsection (b) may also have their vehicle towed by the city at the direction of the housing authority in accordance with the procedures set forth in division 2 of article IV herein.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect on the date of passage.
