

PRESERVATION AWARDS CATEGORIES

PRESERVATION: A HIGH RETENTION OF ALL HISTORIC FEATURES THROUGH CONSERVATION, MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR. IT REFLECTS THE BUILDINGS CONTINUUM OVER TIME AND EMPHASES PRESERVATION OF MATERIALS, FINISHES, SPACES AND SPATIAL RELATIONSHIPS THAT TOGETHER GIVE THE PROPERTY ITS HISTORIC CHARACTER.

REHABILITATION: EMPHASIZES THE RETENTION AND REPAIR OF HISTORIC MATERIALS, WITH MORE LATITUDE FOR REPLACEMENT DUE TO DETERIORATION PRIOR TO WORK

RESTORATION: THESE PROJECTS FOCUS ON THE RETENTION OF MATERIALS FROM THE MOST SIGNIFICANT TIME IN THE PROPERTY'S HISTORY WHILE PERMITTING THE REMOVAL OF MATERIALS FROM OTHER PERIODS. THIS WOULD INCLUDE BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO A SENSITIVE PAINT SCHEME, RESTORATION OF ORIGINAL FEATURES SUCH AS A PORCH OR GARDENS, AND OTHER PROJECTS THAT RESTORE THE FAÇADE OF THE BUILDING.

RECONSTRUCTION: RE-CREATES A NON-SURVIVING SITE, LANDSCAPE, BUILDING, STRUCTURE OR OBJECT IN ALL NEW MATERIALS

INDIVIDUAL/ LOCAL PRESERVATIONIST: THE INDIVIDUAL'S ACHIEVEMENTS AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO LOCAL HISTORIC PRESERVATION
