The Ordinance was passed to be enrolled.


The Committee has considered the same and find that it is truly and properly enrolled.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 26 OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HOLYOKE, MASSACHUSETTS 1997

AN ORDINANCE

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Holyoke as follows:

SECTION 1. Article I entitled "In General" of Chapter 26 entitled "Civil Emergencies" of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Holyoke, Massachusetts, 1997, as amended, is hereby further amended by the following:

ADDING:


Sec. 26-1. Emergency Notification System

The City of Holyoke notification system shall only be used for emergency notifications, to be announced by a non-elected public safety official.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage.
