Ordered, that the City of Holyoke consider a vote to accept the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 60 Section 3F, the law would allow the City to designate a place on its motor vehicle excise tax bills or mail with such bills a separate form whereby taxpayers may voluntarily check off, donate and pledge an amount of money, which shall increase the amount already due, for the purposes of providing support for veterans and their dependents in need of immediate assistance, or take any action relative thereto.
